With Spring fast arriving, it's planting time and K-2 students are all ready!! The children learned that plants need seeds, water, soil and sun to grow and they put aruqula, bean, squash and pea seeds in plastic bags, with soil and water, which they attached to our window. As the seeds developed, the children saw them germinate into plants and then they transplanted them into pots. Now they are observing their development and watering them each day. The plants are thriving and the students are recording their observations in their Plant Growth Journals. Ask your child about their plant's progress.
